I hereby confirm that the abattoir described hereunder is a conditionally registered abattoir in terms of section 8 (1) (b) of the **Meat Safety Act, 2000 (Act No. 40 of 2000)**, and that **Registration No. 8/005** has been allocated thereto.

Note:

This abattoir must at all times comply with the requirements laid down in the Meat Safety Act 2000 (Act No. 40 of 2000). This certificate is not transferable and lapses if for any reason whatsoever ownership of the abattoir changes and/or the abattoir does not comply with the conditions of issue.

Conditions of issue:

- The maximum daily throughput of this abattoir **may not exceed 390 000 units of which the maximum daily throughput of culled birds¹ may not exceed 500 units**, without the prior written consent of the Mpumalanga PEO. "unit" in relation to a quantity standard for determining throughput for poultry, means - (i) one chicken.
- Essential National Standards as prescribed by section 11 of the Act and other relevant sections of the Act to be complied with at all times.
 - **The spin chiller must be managed to ensure that all carcasses are effectively chilled before exiting, as prescribed.**
- All prescribed structural and other required changes to be made within the prescribed period.
- The Hygiene Assessment System (HAS) to be completed by the responsible meat inspection staff at the abattoir and to be verified by a Provincial Veterinary Public Health officer on a quarterly basis.
- Schedule 8 or 9 monthly returns to be submitted on a monthly basis. (As applicable.)
- A detailed waste disposal system including condemned material and effluents to be in place.
- **The validity of this certificate commences on 2023-04-01 and expires on 2024-03-31.**
